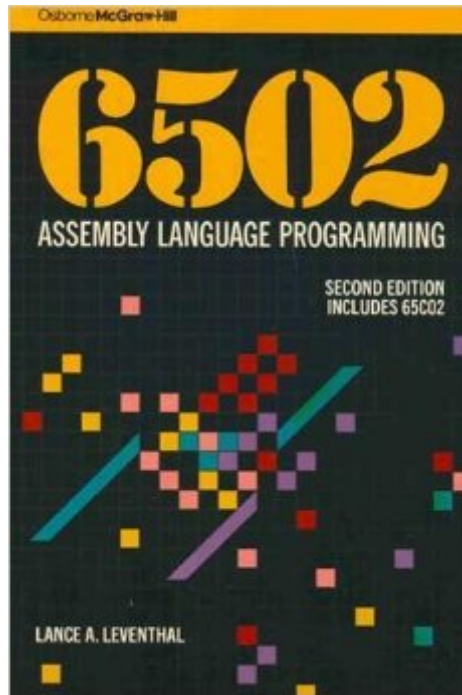


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6502 Assembly Language Programming

Like all the Osbourne microprocessor books from this period, this book is a gem. It has everything you need to know about the 6502 for programming. It covers interfacing with other chips and even gives some timing info and electrical specs for what the signals expect. This is the best 6502 book I owned and I own a lot of them. It is complete and covers everything including some minor code samples. It is not for a specific machine! That part is important. It won't teach you how to program Star Raiders either. So don't think you are getting a "learning to program" guide. It is more of a reference work or a good book for someone with machine language experience and they need to learn this processor fast.

This is a fantastic treasure for my collection. If you can still get a hold of one it is highly recommended. This book deals with the 6502 microprocessor, not any specific brand of computer. This book has examples to illustrate points being made, includes sample project ideas for use with the 6502, and even includes information about the 65C02. Lance is a top-notch writer and knows his stuff. He has also provided references to other material (it could take a long time researching all these references!) and the diagrams and flow charts reinforce concepts.

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
